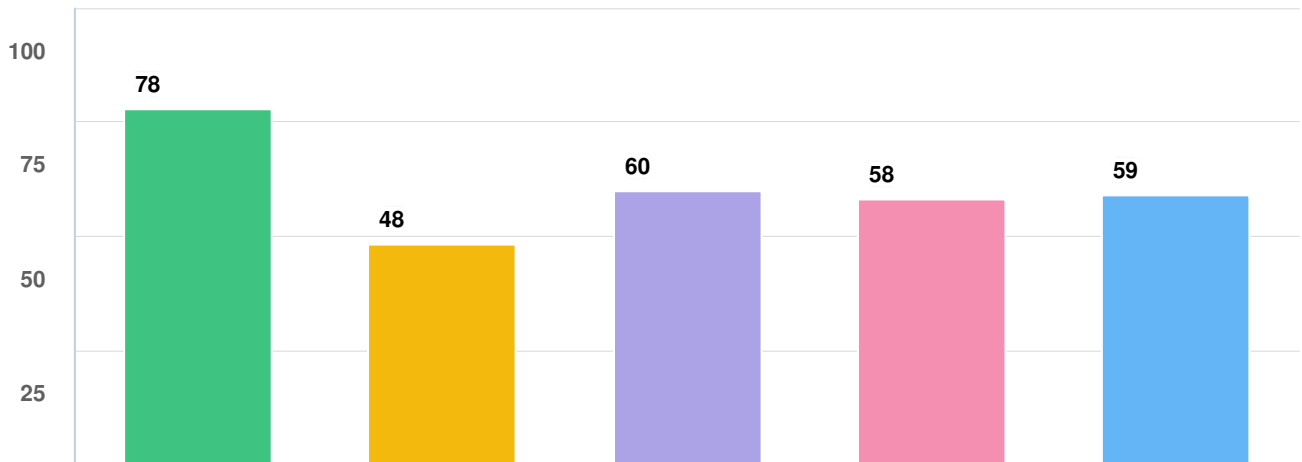

Of the West Avenue Civic Space design options, which are your favorite (2)?

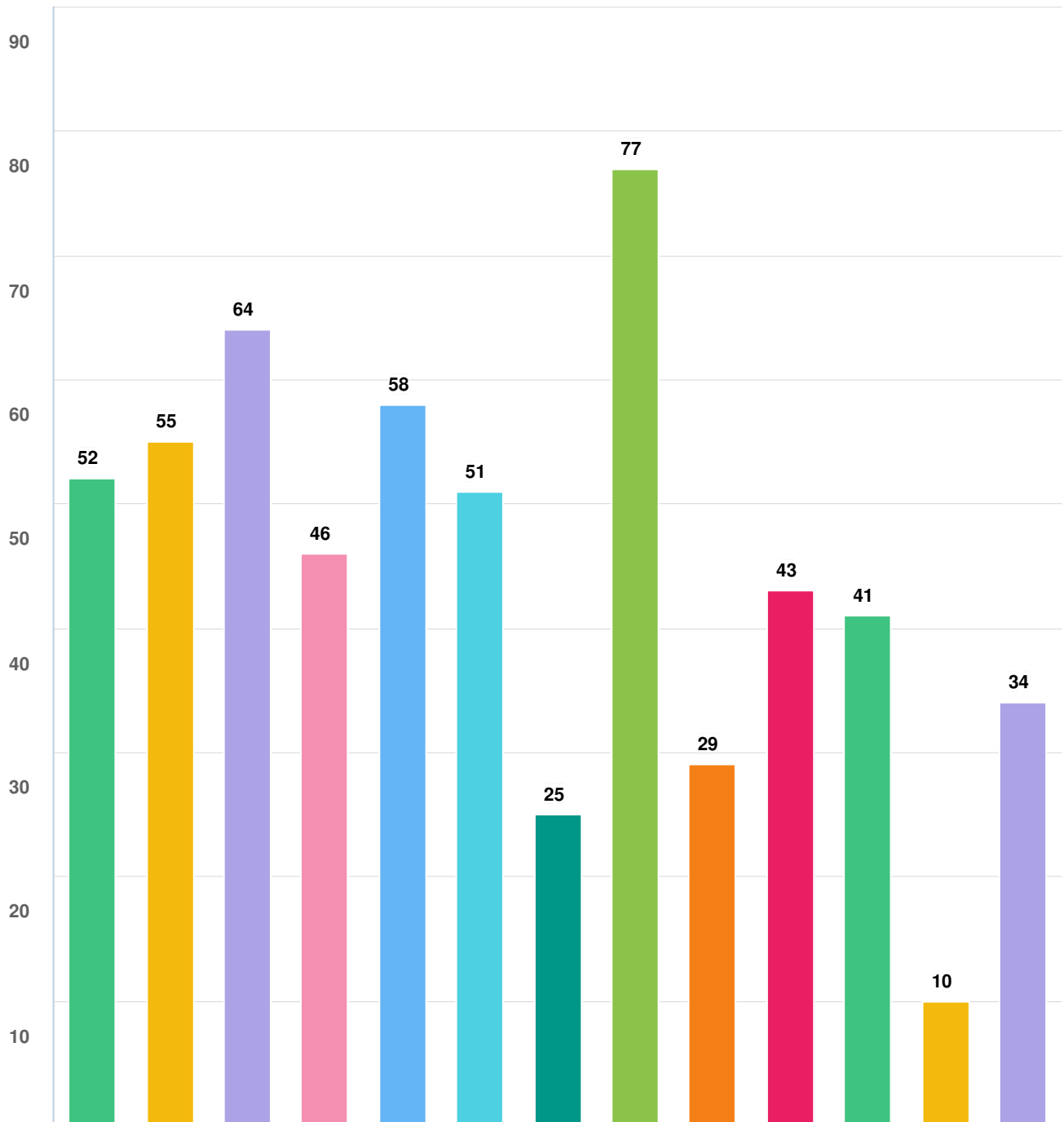

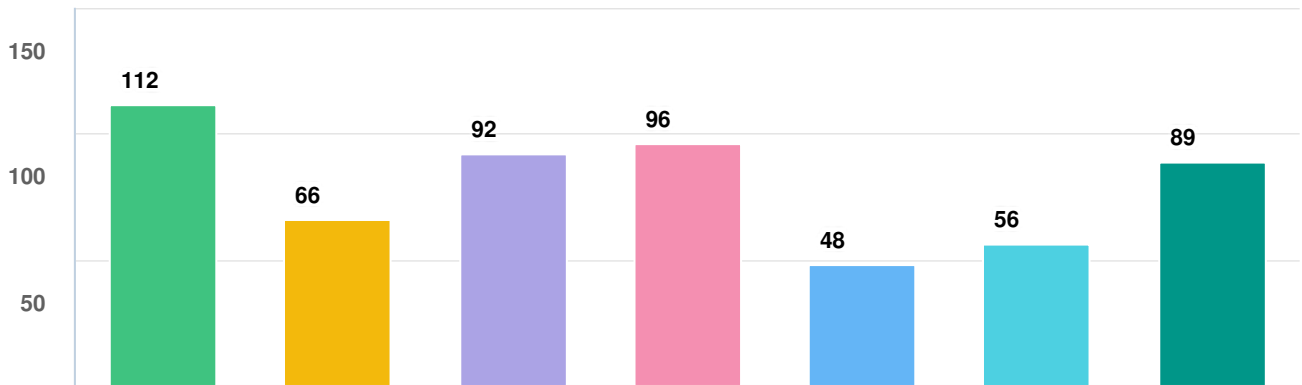

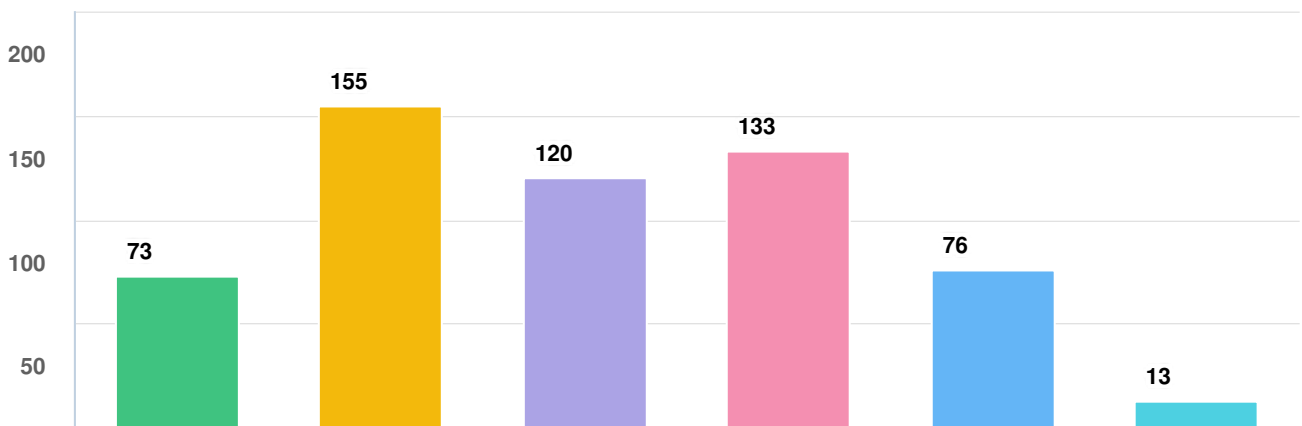

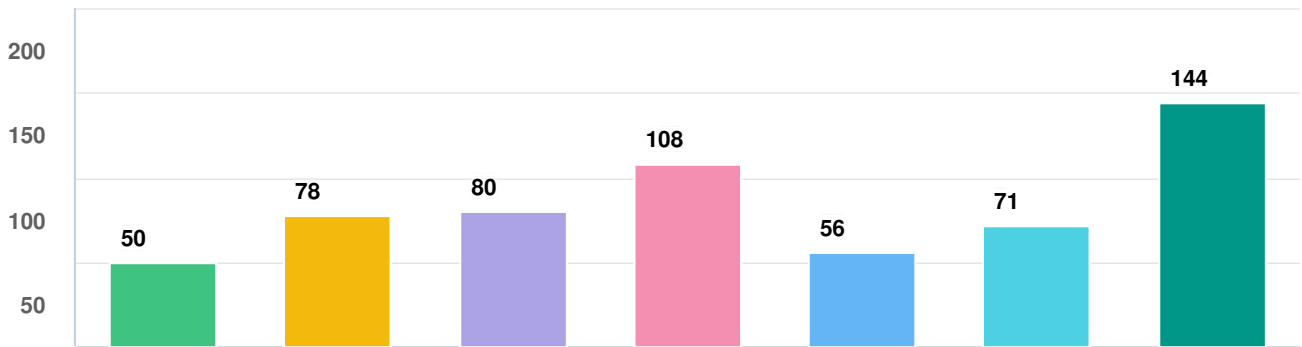

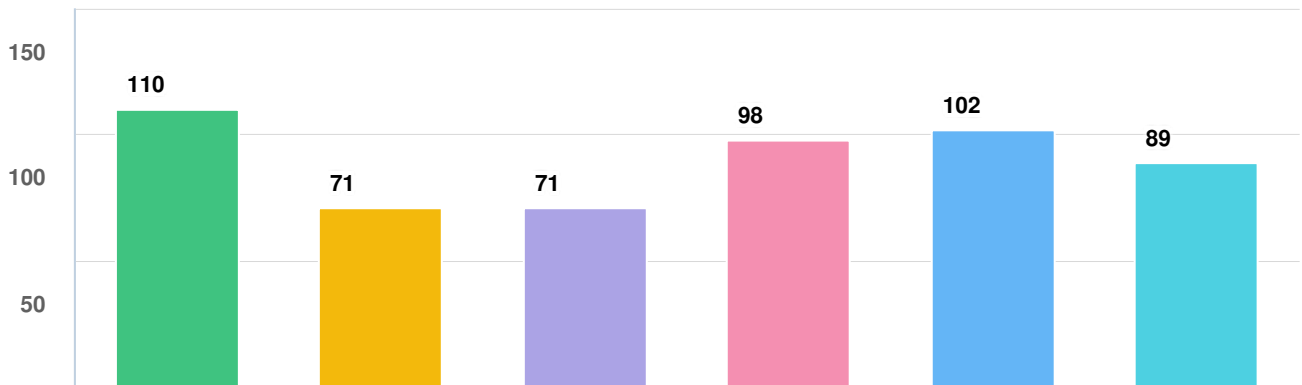

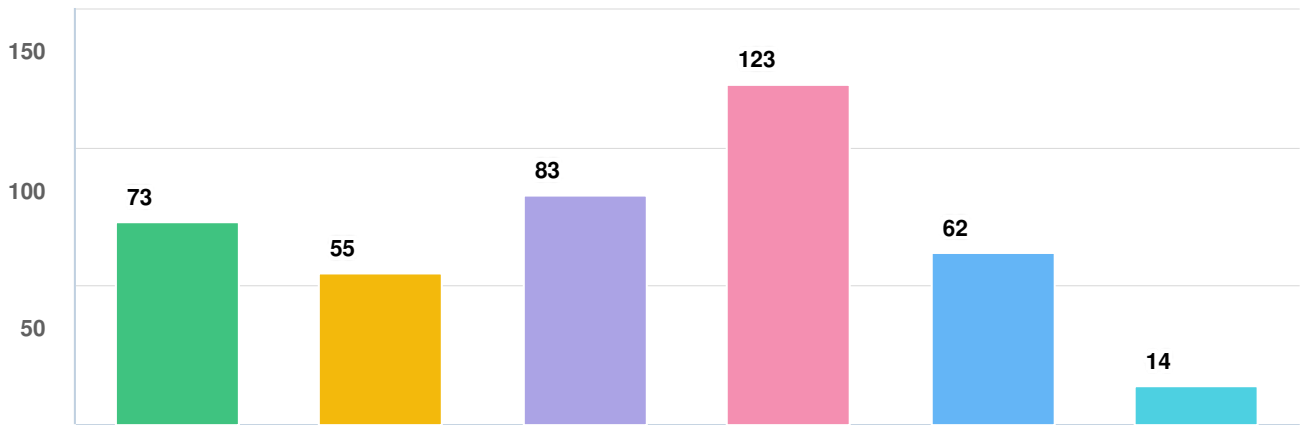
